Categories for Entries

1. Documentary – Open (all ages)
2. Musical video-clip – Open (all ages)
3. Animation – Open (all ages)
4. "60 seconds GO!" – Open (all ages) – Any topic, any genre, maximum of 60 seconds.
5. Comedy
 - a. Youth
 - b. Adult
6. Drama
 - a. Youth
 - b. Adult

Awards will be presented for the best film in each of the above categories.

In addition, entries may be eligible for one of the following awards, if the criteria are met.

- New England connection (Connection by residency or location of filming to New England region of NSW, Australia – based on Australian Federal electoral boundaries)
- Youth (must be predominately the work of students / youth under 18 years)

Awards will also be presented as follows:-

- Best Overall Short Film (Chosen from all entries)
- Audience Choice (votes collected during Friday and Saturday general screenings and the Official Screening)
- Best Technical Film (Chosen from all entries)
- Encouragement Award (Chosen from all entries)

- "G", "PG", or "M" rating.
